

Autotest 2019 proposal.

As we now have very few and only specialised cars in Autotesting, the following is submitted for the 2019 championship to consider.

[9] AUTOTEST CHAMPIONSHIP [9.1] For list of qualifying rounds please refer to the Championship Calendar 2018. [9.2] Classes will be as follows: (A) Saloons up to 11' overall length; (B) Saloons over 11' overall length; (C) Sports Cars; (D) Specials; (E) Road-going saloon cars – being defined as cars that are fully road legal. [9.3] Points for the Overall Championship will be scored on the basis of 15 for 1st overall, 14 for 2nd, etc., down to 1 point for 15th place, between eligible competitors only PLUS 10 points for 1 st in class, 9 for 2nd, etc. down to 1 point for 10th place, taking all competitors into account and based on ANWCC championship classes. [9.4] Trophies will be presented to the 1st & 2 nd Overall; 1 st & 2nd in each class; 1 st & 2nd Junior (under 25 as at 1 January 2018); 1st & 2nd Senior (over 55 as at 1 January 2018); 1st & 2nd Lady Driver. Trophies will also be presented to the 1 st & 2nd overall Novice

[9.2]Classes will be as follows

- (A) Saloon cars, those that are not taxed or tested.
- (B) Sports cars and Specials hood up or down - Cars need not be tax or tested, but could be.
- (C) Road-going saloon cars – being defined as cars that are fully road legal.

[9.3] Points for the Overall Championship will be scored on the basis of 15 for 1st overall, 14 for 2nd, etc., down to 1 point for 15th place, between eligible competitors only PLUS 10 points for 1 st in class, 9 for 2nd, etc. down to 1 point for 10th place, taking all competitors into account and based on classes as run by the event on the day and then put into ANWCC championship classes.
