ROUTE TO VENUE

The venue is Hendrellwyn-y-Maen Farm, near Llangernyw – with the spectacular views of Snowdonia. Please refer to the attached map showing the suggested route to the venue.

The nearest fuel station is Shell at the A55 junction 24 for Abergele. We recommend your using the A548 from Abergele to Llangernyw (9.6 miles) - in the centre of the village turn LEFT immediately before the Stag Inn onto the B5382 (SP Llansannan). Care at narrow bridge and 90° right-hand bend as you leave the village. Continue on the B5382 for one mile, at the top of a hill turn LEFT (narrow) immediately in front of a chapel that has been renovated into a luxury house.

In 0.1 mile turn left at Map Ref 890672, track leads to the Hendre milking parlour (over 500 cows milked twice daily!) – if you are bringing a trailer please park it near the milking parlour but do not obstruct gateways or the access to the milking parlour – space is limited so please park as close as possible. After unloading continue up the hill (arrowed) to the Cymru Field (1 mile from public road to the venue). Do not attempt to tow trailers beyond the trailer park. Note there may be closed gates, which please close after you've driven through, and also "electric" fences – these can be unhitched so cars can get through but please put them back afterwards – hold the insulated handle! Drive with care – take heed of CARE signs!

For those with Sat Nav the post code is LL22 8TE for the farm, co-ordinate for the entrance off the public road is 53.1901N, 3.6628W. The "What 3 Words" for the site entrance are "noodle.baker.animated" and for the HQ it is "open.soups.hushed"!

SIGNING-ON AND SCRUTINEERING PROCEDURE

At the site park neatly, then report to Angela Turner to confirm your presence, between 0930 and 1015 hours. Collect 4 scorecards and your competition number which should be placed at top of windscreen. Signing-on will be the "old" system of physical checking of licences, championship and club cards, and you will sign-on a sheet of paper!

Note that passengers must also complete the signing-on process.

Note that competitors and marshals under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian or bring a Parental Consent Authorization nominating a representative – form can be downloaded from https://www.msauk.org/assets/parentalconsentauthorisation.pdf.

Scrutineering will be conducted where you park - our Scrutineer is Rob Jones.

After you have confirmed attendance and collected your numbers and scorecards you are free to look at the sections on foot. Competitors judged to be attempting a practice run on a section will be penalised 12 marks, all event officials will be deemed to be Judges of Fact.

Competitors must be back at the "office" at 1030 hours for drivers briefing.

RUNNING ORDER

The entry may be split into two groups - Group A will start on Hill 1; Group B will start on Hill 5 – see map – the actual locations may not be quite the same as this depends on conditions when setting up the day before. Proceed in a figure-of-eight one-way route around the site – marshals will NOT be filling in your score cards, so will tell you what score to write down. Add up the scores and hand in card after each round, as you pass HQ. Marshals records will be the definitive score in case of any dispute.

STOP/START & TIMED SECTIONS

We may include a stop/start section, and this may apply to all or some classes only. This will depend on ground conditions, if too dry! The car must stop at the required point, then restart on the marshals instruction. You will be advised if this system is used. NO timed sections.

MISCELLANEOUS

Important that you hand in your score cards to Angela after each round so that we can keep up with scores! Especially important after the final round is to hand your card in promptly, so that we can work out the final positions quickly! Results compiler is Osian Richards of Bala & District Motor Club.

It is our intention to run 4 rounds of 8 hills, but this will depend on time and weather – please be ready to start the hill when it is your turn.

If you know of anyone willing and able to marshal they will be welcomed!

Limited toilet facilities (Tardis type) will be available, should be near HQ. There is no running water on site, the toilet will have sanitizer but it is recommended that you have your own supply.

There will be no refreshments so please ensure you have your own supplies.

Please do not leave litter on the field. Please drive with due care and attention at all times on the site. Only the signed-on driver may drive on the field.

Weather – well, who knows, not even the Meteorological Office! This is Wales so expect anything, or perhaps everything – at least the rain is warmer this time of year – we call it liquid sunshine!

The farm has over 500 milking cattle and they will be going for milking at approx. 3pm – depending on which area of the farm they are grazing this could mean that the exit road is closed for a short period as they make their way to the milking parlour. Please do not try and drive through the procession of cattle.

Results will be announced as soon as possible after the event. They will also be sent out on Saturday evening to your e-mail address. They will also be on <u>www.anwcc.co.uk</u> on Sunday, and BTRDA and Motorsport UK websites and/or Facebook as soon as practical.
