

HISTORIC STAGE RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP SPECIFIC REGULATIONS MSA REGISTRATION No. 33/2008

(Read in conjunction with ANWCC General Regulations)

[HS-1] The qualifying rounds will be as listed overleaf.

[HS-2] Definition of eligible cars is as per MSA regulation H283 to 290 (formerly K37.10).

[HS-3] Competitors will be divided into classes as defined in MSA regulation H295 (formerly K37.12). The eligibility scrutineer appointed for this championship is Chris Mansley (MSA National A), Anat, 9 Cox Green Road, Egerton, Bolton, Lancashire, BL7 9HF.

[HS-4] Where a Historic Stage Rally Championship event is run alongside a rally for modern cars, competitors must compete in the Historic section to be eligible for ANWCC Historic Stage Rally Championship points, but may also be eligible for Forest Rally Championship points if both routes and penalties co-incide.

[HS-5] Points will be scored on each qualifying event on the following basis@ the top 15 (fifteen) registered ANWCC registered drivers and co-drivers will score points on the basis of 15 for 1st, 14 for 2nd, etc., down to 1 point for 15th place.

[HS-6] Additionally, competitors will be awarded points for position in class on the basis of 5 points for 1st, 4 for 2nd, etc. down to 1 point for 5th place. Class points will be based on individual event classification.

[HS-7] The maximum points score per event is 20 (regulation HS-6 + HS-7).

[HS-8] Trophies will be presented to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Overall Driver & Navigator; 1st, 2nd and 3rd in class Driver & Navigator; 1st Junior Driver & Co-Driver (under 25 as at 1 January 2008).

Trophies will also be presented to the 1st, 2nd & 3rd Novice competitors, the 1st in each class and the 1st Newcomer as defined in regulations NHS-1 to NHS-7 below. Competitors winning overall awards will not be eligible for class awards.

[NHS-1] A Novice competitor is defined as one who, in the role now entered, has not won more than one class or overall award on a Historic Stage Rally event of National B, Restricted or higher status, at the time of registering for the Championship. Claims for Novice status must be indicated on the Championship Registration Form. Marque, Ladies, Mixed Crew, Club and Team awards are discounted for the purpose of Novice definition.

[NHS-2] A newcomer is defined as a Novice competitor who has not been registered for any ANWCC Championship in previous years, and who does not take any other championship award.

[NHS-3] Previous winners of an ANWCC Championship will not be eligible for Novice status regardless of regulation NHS-1 above.

[NHS-4] In each class a competitor finishing 1st will be awarded 15 points, second 14 points, etc. down to 1 point for 15th class finisher. This takes into account all competitors in class, classes taken as for individual events.

[NHS-5] 5 additional points will be awarded to the highest placed eligible ANWCC championship contender in overall classification, 4 points for the second highest, etc., down to 1 point for the fifth highest.

[NHS-6] For the purpose of regulation NHS-5 Drivers and Co-Drivers will score separately.

[NHS-7] The maximum points score per event is 20 (regulations NHS-4 + NHS-5).
